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INSTRUMENT INTRODUCTION

WOODWINDS

Flute Very common. Inexpensive to rent. Fits easily into backpack to carry.

Minor physical restrictions. 8-10 per class

*Oboe Same length as the flute. Double reed. Interesting sound. Requires

patience, good study habits and self-motivation. Can be rented. Some

restrictions. 2 per class

Clarinet Very popular instrument. Inexpensive to rent. Fits easily into backpacks.

Few restrictions. Basic fingerings lead to sax & flute. 18 per class

*Bassoon Wonderful instrument. Has very unique sound. Cannot be rented. Very

important to groups! Requires patience, good study habits and self-

motivation. Extra credit for achievers. 2 per class

Saxophone Popular instrument. More expensive to rent (must be rented). Case is bigger

& heavier to carry back & forth to school. Not forgiving when bumped. We

suggest kids start on the clarinet. 6 per class

BRASS/PERCUSSION

Trumpet Popular instrument. Inexpensive to rent. Some restrictions. 8-10 per class

*Horn Glorious middle voice instrument! Has a very warm & pleasant sound. Can

be rented. Very important to groups! Requires patience, good study habits, and self-motivation. Previous musical experience very helpful. Extra credit

for achievers. 6 per class

*Trombone Great lower voice instrument. Has a very nice sound. Inexpensive to rent.

Very important to groups! Requires patience, good study habits, and self-motivation. Previous musical experience very helpful. Extra credit for

achievers. 8 per class

*Baritone Nice lower voice instrument. Can be rented (but expensive). 2 per class

**Tuba The MOST IMPORTANT VOICE IN THE GROUP! Wonderful low voice

instrument. Has great sound. Cannot be rented. Requires patience, good study habits and self-motivation. Extra credit for achievers. 3 per class

Percussion Includes battery (drums & cymbals) and mallets. Piano experience strongly

THINGS TO CONSIDER

You have been (or will be) introduced to the various instruments. Due to the nature of our Music program, we assist each student in deciding the appropriate instrument.

There are many factors to consider when beginning an instrument. In the scores of years that music has been in the schools, it has been noticed that certain physical and non-physical attributes of a child guide, and occasionally dictate the choice of instrument.

During the next few weeks, we will work together to determine the correct instrument for your child.

REMEMBER: These factors MUST be considered when selecting an instrument:

- * Instrument/Student size
- * Student Needs
- * Anacapa's needs
- * Cost of playing (reeds/oil ...)
- * Ability to transport to school
- * Rental prices
- * Availability of School instruments

- * Physical make-up of child
- * Cost of repair/maintenance
- * Size/weight of case
- * Accessibility (own/buy/rent/school)
- * Practice time needed
- * Possibility of having to share an instrument with other students
